CALL TO ORDER

Dan Langford called to order the October 15, 2018, ESD Board meeting starting at 5:05 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

No public in attendance.

MINUTES

Dan Langford asked if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes from the September 17, 2018 Board Meeting. The following corrections should be noted: Top of Page 4, SJ - "How often do we have to replace the props?"; Page 5, first sentence, add comma in first sentence; Page 5, million vs. billion; Page 6, period to be placed at end of sentence after \$9,000.00.

Ken Koenig made a motion to approve minutes noting the corrections as presented. Dan Dronberger seconded with unanimous approval of the board.

FINANCIAL REPORT

To receive a financial report from the District Treasurer and to consider and approve payment for invoices as submitted and other financial matters, including, but not limited to the following:

Dan Dronberger passed out the monthly reports. Review and discussion held by the board.

Dan Dronberger reported on the bank balances in our various accounts as of September 30, 2018.

Checking Account: We had a beginning balance of \$538,981.23, with deposits totaling \$208,907.43 (which includes an interest deposit of \$152.23); checks and debits totaling \$721,932.55, for an ending balance of \$25,956.11.

Money Market Account: We started with a beginning balance of \$415,978.99, with an interest deposit of \$284.93; Debits totaling \$66,000.00; for an ending balance of \$350,263.92.

Sales Tax Money Market Account: Beginning balance of \$2,676,468.80 with deposits totaling \$119,618.07 (which includes an interest deposit of \$1,980.54), Debits totaling \$25,000.00; for an ending balance of \$2,771,086.87.

FIRE CHIEF REPORT

Fire Chief's report of service provisions and PVFA business.

Fire Responses - 183 Total Responses

Major Response:

9/2 - Cypress Station, Intracare Hospital, electrical short; minor 9/9 - Commerical - Roofing Company, mutual aid with Little York FD

Other Current and Long Range information exchange

PVFA 2019 Budget: Current health insurance had a 61.63% increase over current coverage; three providers being considered; firefighters currently have full coverage at no cost; may need to request contributions from firefighters.

Staffing Plan Station 2: Cannot afford to fully staff with three firefighters 24/7; may possibly staff with 2 firefighters per station; considering a brown out of station 62 on lowest volume days, being Wednesday and Thursday. Review of staffing plan at next meeting.

One full-time firefighter no longer with the Department; new full-time employee to begin work on October 22, 2018.

Considering purchase of ATT modems though the coverage in District is limited. This is part of the First Net Plan for first responders.

Station 61's dormitory modification is almost complete, closing doors to add more privacy. Cost approximately \$4,000; we received funds from FEMA in the amount of \$4,500 to help cover costs associated with modification.

To receive an update regarding the traffic preemption program with GTT.

Chief Windisch reported that the ILA in progress and he had completed the form provided by GTT.

Review, discuss and take any necessary action regarding the Training Facility Upgrade.

Chief Windisch reported the Car Fire Prop as being delivered and weighing in at 3,000 pounds which will be installed in November. Purchase Order information has not yet been received from the vendor. No action taken.

To receive an update regarding current and long-range information planning. Nothing to report

To receive an update regarding the ISO evaluation of the Department.

Internal approvals were accessible on October 12th for which a report will be presented at the November meeting. No action taken.

Review, discuss and take action regarding entering into an agreement with Municipal Information Services and to have Dr. Ron Welch provide economic development information for the District.

Dr. Welch presented a report including the following: increase in construction of single family homes; "Habitat for Humanity" is being built behind the CVS; taxable values reviewed; 108.7 previously agricultural exempt or residential is now classified as commercial; approximately 48,000 people in the District; price of oil is increasing as well as oil equipment and material; oil and gas responsible for roughly 50% of job growth in Texas; and Houston's employment growth is approximately 3%.

Dr. Welch directed the Board's attention to Page 19 stating he had spent a great deal of time in the District. Chief Windisch commented on the revenue number provided by Dr. Welch as he felt the percentage collected was too low. No action taken.

Report on the President's participation in the Emergency Response Leadership Coalition

No attendance.
